

**for the preparation of national reports
pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004)**

All States are called upon to present to the Committee a first report, not later than six months from the adoption of the resolution 1540(2004), i.e. 28 October 2004, on steps they have taken or intend to take to implement this resolution.

All States are called upon to report to the Committee on steps they have taken or intend to take to implement the provisions of operative paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of the resolution 1540 (2004).

All States are also called upon to include, if appropriate, in their national reports information relating to the implementation of operative paragraphs 6,7,8, 9 and 10 of the resolution 1540 (2004).

None of the obligations set forth in resolution 1540(2004) shall be interpreted so as to conflict with or alter the rights and obligations of States Parties to the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty, the Chemical Weapons Convention and the Biological and Toxin Weapons Convention or alter the responsibilities of the IAEA or the OPCW.
